Public Art Commission Agreement with artist team Anton R. T. Morton and James Tapscott, for a site-specific work of land art for the Lake Hefner Golf Course Clubhouse, 4491 South Lake Hefner Drive, \$39,292. Ward 2.

Location:

4491 South Lake Hefner Drive.

Purpose:

Approve an Agreement with Anton R. T. Morton and James Tapscott, dba Kasum Contemporary Fine Art, Inc. (Artists), for a 1% for Art site-specific work of land art titled "Cut Line" (Work).

Background:

A Call to Artists (RFQ) was announced in BidSync on November 8, 2023. A Selection Committee reviewed the responses to the RFQ received by the deadline of December 6, 2023, and selected Finalists who later attended a mandatory site tour and subsequently made presentations of site-specific conceptual design reports. The Selection Committee recommended Artists' design as the most appropriate public art for this project. The Arts Commission met on January 26, 2024 (Item No. III.E.) and concurred with the Selection Committee's recommendation. On February 13, 2024 (Item No. MFA.A) the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority approved a Public Art Commission Agreement with Artists for the Work's design phase, which is now complete.
