Oklahoma City Airport Trust Joint Use Agreement with the United States of America, by and through the National Guard Bureau, and the State of Oklahoma, to provide for the use, in common with others, of the Joint Use Flying Facilities, the delineation of responsibilities, and the establishment of the Government's reasonable share, proportional to its use of the cost of operating and maintaining the facilities, Will Rogers World Airport, retroactive to October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2034. Ward 3.

Location:

Will Rogers World Airport

Background:

Title 49, United States Code, Chapter 471, Sections 47101-47129 provides that an Airport's facilities developed with financial assistance from the U.S. Government (USG) and each of the Airport's facilities usable for the landing and taking off of aircraft will always be available without charge for use by USG aircraft in common with other aircraft, except that if the use is substantial, the USG may be charged a reasonable share proportionate to the use of the cost of operating and maintaining the facilities.

The USG has determined that its operations have projected the USG's reasonable share of its substantial operations proportionate to its use, of the cost of operating and maintaining the facilities. Payments will be made by the State of Oklahoma, by and through the National Guard Bureau.

The City of Oklahoma City is not a party to the Joint Use Agreement with the USG, by and through the National Guard Bureau, and the State of Oklahoma, but is approving the Joint Use Agreement as required by the City's Lease Agreement with the Oklahoma City Airport Trust.

Revenue:

\$100,379.85 annually; subject to annual CPI adjustments for the year affected. Project Account – OKCAT – Airports – National Guard – Apron Rental (8000-REV2000- A0139-41650001).
