## The City of OKLAHOMA CITY

Joint Resolution with The City of Oklahoma City authorizing the Director of Risk Management and the Trust's legal counsel to enter into a Joint Petition Settlement of the Workers' Compensation Commission Claim No. CM3-2021-00970H styled: *James Deering, Claimant vs. The City of Oklahoma City, Respondent*, an Own Risk Carrier, and further authorizing the Municipal Counselor to assist said counsel in the rendition of said Joint Petition Settlement to Judgment as authorized by 85 O.S. §346, 62 O.S. §§365.1 *et seq.* and Article 10, Section 28 of the Oklahoma Constitution.

### Background:

The Claimant, James Deering is 41 years old and a 15-year employee of The City of Oklahoma City. At the time of the injury he was assigned to the Fire Department as a Lieutenant and continues to be employed by the City.

The Claimant sustained an undisputed accidental injury on December 23, 2020 to the left eye and right eye.

The Claimant was evaluated by Dr. Lance E. Rosson on behalf of his attorney and found to have the following permanent partial impairment: left eye 14%, right eye 14%. The Claimant was also evaluated by Dr. William Jones on behalf of the City and found to have the following permanent partial impairment: left eye 7%, right eye 5%. The negotiated Joint Petition Settlement calls for a PPD award of \$20,212.50 for the following permanent partial disability: left eye 10%, right eye 11%. The settlement includes an additional payment of \$8,000, for future medical for a total award of \$28,212.50.

The settlement further calls for a 3% assessment of the PPD award, less the additional payment amount, in the sum of \$606.38 be deducted and paid on behalf of the Claimant for the Multiple Injury Trust Fund Tax, making the lump sum award, including the additional payment, \$27,606.12. The settlement further calls for \$5,642.50 to be deducted from the PPD award and paid in a lump sum to Claimant's attorney as a fair and reasonable fee. In addition, the City will pay Court costs \$140, a Special Occupational and Safety Fund tax representing .75% of the permanent partial disability award, less the additional payment amount, shall be paid in the sum of \$151.59 and the Workers' Compensation Administration Fund, representing 2% of the permanent partial disability award, less the additional payment amount, shall be paid in the sum of \$404.25.
