Preliminary Report, Project MB-1649, Driving Facility at the Public Safety Training Facility, between I-240 and SE 104th Street, South Air Depot Boulevard and South Midwest Boulevard; and authorizing preparation of final plans and specifications. Ward 4.

Location:

Between I-240, SE 104th Street, South Air Depot Boulevard and South Midwest Boulevard

Background:

This American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) project provides for high-speed driving track with a straight-away and banked curves, a 5,047 square foot driver training building with restrooms, offices, a training room, and a drive-through vehicle bay where tires can be repaired. A driving skill pad will be built adjacent to the track.

Final Plans are expected in Summer 2024, with construction scheduled to begin in early 2025.
