Title of Item: Ordinance Amending the Oklahoma City to be introduced, set for public hearing February 27, 2024, and final adoption March 26, 2024 amending Municipal Code 2020, Chapter 32, Article II, Division 2, Sections 32-46 Created Supervisory Department, 32-47 Powers and Duties, 32-48 Establishment of Parking Enforcement Specialists and the Powers and Duties granted to Parking Enforcement Specialists, 32-49 Interference with Parking Regulation Enforcement Official, and Division 5, Sections 32-116 Citation Forms Generally, and 32-128 Citations for Illegal Parking.

Originating Department: Public Transportation and Parking

Description of Impact

The proposed amendment to Chapter 32 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, was initiated by a request submitted by the Central Oklahoma Transportation and Parking Authority further clarify what positions within the City of Oklahoma City have the authority to issue parking citations to parties utilizing the On-Street Parking Program. This ordinance specifies that Parking Enforcement Technicians under the supervision of the Public Transportation and Parking Department have the authority to issue Parking Citations for "Parked at Expired Meter" and "Overtime Parking".

Summary of Impact

a. Cost to City Organization: N/A

b. Cost to Citizens:

The quantity of citations being issued to those utilizing the On-Street Parking may increase since a dedicated team will be focused on the compliance for those parked in Time Limited or Pay to Park parking spaces depending on the current level of compliance.

c. Cost to Business Community:

The Business Community will not be providing any monetary support; however, they have requested and encourage increased compliance by those that utilize the On-Street Parking Program.

d. Revenue Produced:

An increase to revenue generated from the On-Street Parking Program's Parking Meters is possible should compliance be low.
