Background:

As a part of the MAPS 4 Program, The City of Oklahoma City will improve areas along the Oklahoma River. The improvements could include a new pedestrian bridge, community stage, and low-water dam near the First Americans Museum; and upgrades to the riverbank and other public lands.

The structural steel beams have been built, and the contractor has satisfied the requirements of the contract. Staff recommends accepting the project and placing Maintenance Bond No. 9432160 with Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland into effect.
