Resolution approving travel expenses for Councilmembers Bradley Carter and Nikki Nice to attend the Greater Oklahoma City Chamber of Commerce InterCity Visit 2022 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin from August 24-26, 2022.

Background:

City Councilmembers Bradley Carter and Nikki Nice request authorization for travel to attend the Greater Oklahoma City Chamber of Commerce InterCity Visit 2022 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin from August 24-26, 2022.

Participants will learn from Milwaukee's civic and business leaders about city's activation of the waterfront, cultivating a dynamic and innovative entrepreneurship culture, housing-first approach which has decrease homelessness, affordable housing options, festivals, education reform initiatives and diversity, equity and inclusion initiatives. In addition, attendees will tour Fiserv Forum, home of the Milwaukee Bucks and the surrounding Deer District which is Milwaukee's newest neighborhood designed for residents to live, work and play.

The Charter of The City of Oklahoma City states that travel by Mayor and City Council members on behalf of The City receive prior approval by two-thirds vote of the Council, where reimbursement of expenses is sought. This resolution requests authorization for Councilmembers Bradley Carter and Nikki Nice to initiate travel prior to August 24, 2022 and beyond August 26, 2022 and be reimbursed for expenses incurred during this travel period. The estimated cost for each Councilmember is \$981.19. The \$981.19 will cover reimbursement for airfare and meals.
