Resolution re-establishing the wireline nine-one-one (9-1-1) emergency telephone fee of three percent for calendar year 2023.

Background:

On March 17, 1987, the voters of the City of Oklahoma City approved Ordinance No. 18,672, which is now codified as amended in Sections 15-71 through 15-78 of Article IV of Chapter 15 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020.

Provisions of Section 15-75 of the 9-1-1 Emergency Number Ordinance require that an emergency telephone fee be established each year, and Section 15-76 states that the fee shall be set each year.

The amount of the fee for wireline phones has been 3% since February 1, 1990 and as currently established, cannot exceed 3%. This resolution reaffirms the original tariff that was created to implement and support the 9-1-1 emergency system.
