Resolution ratifying and approving execution of Community Development Block Grant funding agreements with sub-grantees awarded funds in the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Fourth Year Annual Action Plan. Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Background:

The City of Oklahoma City received a federal allocation of \$4,907,677 in CDBG funds for FY 2023-24. A portion of the funds was subsequently allocated to Subrecipients and Grantees within the FY 2023-24 Fourth Year Annual Action Plan. Funds were provided to operate eligible community development programs and conduct activities in support of the City's strategic goals and objectives, as identified in the FY 2020-2024 Five Year Consolidated Plan, and FY 2023-23 Fourth Year Action Plan. The Action Plan was approved by City Council on May 9, 2023 (Item No. XI.W.)

The Resolution approving the FY 2023-24 Fourth Year Action Plan provided authority for the Mayor to sign funding agreements with nine (9) identified sub-grantees. It is noted that SISU Youth Services was listed in error, as it is still funded under a previous year's agreement and was not allocated new funds this program year.

The Resolution also required that signed copies of the Final Agreements be submitted to City Council for ratification, and the remaining eight (8) contracts are hereby attached. They include:

- Community Action Agency-Emergency Home Repair Program.
- Community Action Agency-Small Business Assistance Program.
- Community Health Centers, Inc.- Healing Hands Program. (Inadvertently identified in the Action Plan Resolution as Community Health Services, Inc.)
- Court Appointed Special Advocates of Oklahoma County, Inc.- Foster Care Advocacy program.
- Oklahoma City Urban Renewal Agency-Slum/Blight Remediation, and Mirimar Sewer Extension.
- Oklahoma City Housing Authority Public Housing Rehab program.
- Metropolitan Fair Housing- Fair Housing Programs.
- Central Oklahoma Transportation and Parking Authority-Share-A-Fare program-homeless transportation services.
