Ordinance on final hearing (emergency) recommended for approval (five affirmative votes required for approval) (SPUD-1663) rezoning 7900 North MacArthur Boulevard from SPUD-79 Simplified Planned Unit Development District to SPUD-1663 Simplified Planned Unit Development District. Ward 1.

Purpose:

The purpose of this request is to allow commercial development, specifically to expand the existing automotive shop use.

Background:

On September 26, 2024, the Planning Commission recommended approval of the application subject to the amended Summary of Technical Evaluation contained in the Planning Commission staff report, as follows. The applicant has agreed with these conditions and the SPUD document has been amended accordingly.

Amended Technical Evaluation:

1. Modify Section 8. Signs to state that freestanding signs shall be in accordance with the City of Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, as amended.
2. No more than 16 cars awaiting repair or for sale shall be permitted on the property at one time.
