

RESOLUTION EXTENDING TIME TO AWARD THE CONTRACT FOR THE MAPS 4 BIKE LANES PHASE 1A; AWARDING CONTRACT TO RCC TRAFFIC, LLC, \$1,896,069.75; AND APPROVING CONTRACT AND BONDS, PROJECT M4-TK010.

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2019, the voters of The City of Oklahoma City voted to approve the levy of the Oklahoma City Capital Improvements Sales Tax for the MAPS 4 Program; and

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2020, the City Council established the MAPS 4 Citizens Advisory Board for the purposes of advising the City Council regarding projects proposed for funding from the Oklahoma City Capital Improvements Sales Tax; and

WHEREAS, as part of the MAPS 4 Program, The City of Oklahoma City will construct several miles of bike lanes; and

WHEREAS, this project is the MAPS 4 Bike Lanes Phase 1A, Project M4-TK010; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on February 5, 2025 for Project M4-TK010 with two bids received; and

WHEREAS, provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act mandate that a contract for construction be awarded within 30 days of bid opening but no more than 45 days upon mutual written agreement between the contractor and City; and

WHEREAS, due to the timing of the receipt of the bids and the MAPS 4 Connectivity Subcommittee, MAPS 4 Citizens Advisory Board and City Council meetings, it is necessary to extend the time to award the contract; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid submitted by Action Safety Supply Co., LLC, had the bid bond made to the incorrect awarding agency, which is a fatal flaw; and

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bidder, RCC Traffic, LLC, has agreed to hold the bid prices until the contract is awarded; and

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed the bids and recommend awarding the contract to the lowest and best bidder, RCC Traffic, LLC, in an amount of \$1,896,069.75 for Project M4-TK010, MAPS 4 Bike Lanes Phase 1A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of The City of Oklahoma City to extend the time to award the contract for Project M4-TK010, MAPS 4 Bike Lanes Phase 1A; approve the contract with RCC Traffic, LLC in an amount of \$1,896,069.75; and approve the contract and bonds.
