Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in approving Amendment No. 3 to the Contract for Engineering Services with Garver, LLC, Project WC-0871, Atoka Pipeline Raw Water Transmission Line, Atoka Pump Station O to Coalgate, fee of increase \$563,974.

Location:

Atoka Pump Station O to Coalgate

Background:

The City of Oklahoma City owns and the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust operates and maintains a 100-mile long, 60-inch raw water pipeline and six pump stations bringing water from the Atoka Reservoir in southeast Oklahoma to the Stanley Draper Reservoir in southeast Oklahoma City. A new 72-inch raw water pipeline will be constructed parallel to the existing pipeline.

The original contract allowed for 23 months of construction. Subsequent to execution of the original contract as previously amended, the construction contract has been awarded and the construction period has increased to 27 months. The Design Engineer will be required to perform additional Construction Administration, Pipe Inspection Services, Construction Inspection Services, and As-Builts Services. Additionally, it was determined to increase Exhibit E-Additional Services, to provide up to an additional four months of Task 4C, Construction Inspection Services should the construction period be extended beyond 27 months. Unused funds in completed tasks will be re-allocated to fund a portion of this amendment.

The original contract must be amended to provide for the Design Engineer's increased scope of work as outlined above and associated fees.
