RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND APPROVING EXECUTION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING AGREEMENTS WITH SUB-GRANTEES AWARDED FUNDS IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 FIFTH YEAR ANNUAL ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS, The City of Oklahoma City (City) has received allocations of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds since 1975, to primarily benefit persons of low income; and

WHEREAS, CDBG funding for FY 2024-2025, in the amount of \$5,055,205, was authorized through a federal allocation of funds by Congress to the City, for the performance period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of The City of Oklahoma City to commit the use of these funds in the most efficient way possible, to meet the needs of its populations of those with lower incomes; including the use of subgrants to partner agencies; and

WHEREAS, City Council's July 2, 2024 Resolution approving the FY 2024-2025 Fifth Year Annual Action Plan (Item No. XI.V.) authorized the Mayor to sign funding agreements with sub-grantees, including the Alpha Community Foundation, Central Oklahoma Transportation and Parking Authority, Community Action Agency, Community Health Centers, Inc., Court Appointed Special Advocates of Oklahoma County, Metropolitan Fair Housing Agency, NewView Oklahoma, Oklahoma City Housing Authority, and Oklahoma City Urban Renewal Authority;

WHEREAS, the City has executed Agreements with partnering agencies to implement direct funding allocations to Subgrantees identified in the Resolution approving the FY 2024-2025 Fifth Year Annual Action Plan approved by City Council on July 2, 2024; and

WHEREAS, all executed CDBG Agreements approved on July 2, 2024 have been fully executed by all parties, and are ready for ratification;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of The City of Oklahoma City hereby ratifies and approves the Mayor's execution of the following:

1. CDBG Funding Agreements with Alpha Community Foundation, Central Oklahoma Transportation and Parking Authority, Community Action Agency (Emergency Home Repair and Small Business Assistance), Community Health Centers, Inc., Court Appointed Special Advocates of Oklahoma County, Metropolitan Fair Housing Agency, NewView Oklahoma, Inc., Oklahoma City Housing Authority, and Oklahoma City Urban Renewal Authority.
