

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF \$340,587.13 GRANT FROM THE OKLAHOMA HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE; RATIFYING SUBMITTAL OF THE INTERNET BASED APPLICATION BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT BUSINESS MANAGER, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE POLICE BUSINESS MANAGER OR MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST TO SUBMIT THE INTERNET ACCEPTANCE, REQUESTS FOR FUNDS, PROVIDE REPORTS AS REQUIRED, AND TO ADMINISTER THE GRANT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO RECEIVE AND DEPOSIT THE FUNDS IN THE GRANTS MANAGEMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, this grant provides continued funding for the Oklahoma City Impaired Driving Enforcement Program, the Oklahoma City Seat Belt Enforcement Program and the Oklahoma City Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Enforcement Program as directed by the Oklahoma Highway Safety Office (OHSO); and

WHEREAS, the grant period is October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, this will be the twenty seventh continuous year of funding for enforcement programs; and

WHEREAS, the grant provides overtime funding of \$340,587.13 for officers and supervisors to work enforcement shifts on weekends, holidays and any other days approved by OSHO; and

WHEREAS, the City will provide up to \$146,000 for the program as matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the funding for the City's portion was included in the FY 2025 Police Department budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Oklahoma City that the City is authorized to accept the award for the 2025 Oklahoma Highway Safety Office Grant of \$340,587.13.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of

Oklahoma City that the submittal of the internet-based application by the City Manager and the Police Department Business Manager is ratified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the Mayor is authorized to sign any necessary documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the Police Business Manager or Management Specialist are authorized to submit the internet acceptance, requests for funds, provide reports as required, and administer the grant and the City Treasurer is authorized to receive and deposit these funds into Grants Management Fund.
