AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 59, SECTION 5150 OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL CODE, 2020, TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY WITHIN THE RA2 SINGLE-FAMILY TWO-ACRE RURAL RESIDENTIAL AND AE-2 AIRPORT ENVIRONS ZONE TWO OVERLAY DISTRICTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 59, Section 5150 of The Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, be amended to change the boundaries of the RA2 Single-Family Two-Acre Rural Residential and AE-2 Airport Environs Zone Two Overlay Districts, as shown upon the District Map to include therein the following described property:

Part of the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Section Eight (8), Township Ten (10) North, Range One (1) West of the Indian Meridian, Cleveland County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a Point 990.00 feet South and 33.00 feet West of the Northeast Corner of the Northeast Quarter, Thence South a distance of 361.79 feet; Thence West a distance of 602.00 feet; Thence North a distance of 361.79 feet; Thence East a distance of 602.00 feet to the Point or Place of Beginning.

SECTION 2. (EMERGENCY) WHEREAS, it being immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety, and public good of Oklahoma City and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of the ordinance be put into full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from and after its passage as provided by law.
