**SUBJECT:** MARCH 31, 2023 QUARTERLY INVESTMENT REPORT

Annualized return on the portfolio was 2.23% for the quarter and 1.78% fiscal year to date. Investment income was \$11.89 million for the quarter and \$28.15 million year-to-date. As per the Federal Open Market Committee's March 23<sup>rd</sup> statement on the economy, recent indicators point to modest growth in spending and production. Job gains have increased recently and unemployment is low. Inflation remains elevated. On March 23, the Committee raised the federal funds rate to a target range of 4.75 to 5.00 percent and anticipates that additional firming may be appropriate to return inflation to 2 percent over time. The federal funds rate has a significant influence on the interest earnings of the portfolio.

The City's investment policy incorporates City Charter, Municipal Code and state statute requirements and establishes objectives for the investment of City funds. These objectives, in order of priority are safety, liquidity and return on investment. The investment policy also requires an investment report be submitted to the Mayor and Council on a quarterly basis.

Following is an executive summary of the investment activity for City, trust and authority funds administered by the City Treasurer for the quarter ended March 31, 2023.
