**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNSELOR TO CONFESS JUDGMENT WITHOUT ADMITTING LIABILITY IN THE CASE OF *MICHAEL AARON KRAUSE, SPECIAL ADMINISTRATOR OF THE ESTATE OF MAX KRAUSE, JR., DECEASED* v. *CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY*, IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF OKLAHOMA COUNTY, CJ-2021-5**

**WHEREAS**, the lawsuit styled *Michael Aaron Krause, Special Administrator of the Estate of Max Krause, Jr. v. City of Oklahoma City* has been filed in the District Court for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma;


**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that a settlement of One Hundred and Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000) is a just and reasonable settlement of said case;


