Resolution of support for The City of Oklahoma City's continued participation in the Stockyards City Main Street Program as established by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for FY 2023-2024. Ward 6.

Location:

The business district area is in the vicinity of South Agnew and Exchange Avenues, in the area commonly known as Stockyards City Main Street.

Background:

The Main Street Four Point Approach is a national program under the National Trust for Historic Preservation and requires each Main Street district to garner support from its local government. Using the Four Points: Organization, Promotion, Design, and Economic Vitality, the community works to achieve sustainable revitalization of the district.

The City of Oklahoma City has supported Stockyards City Main Street since its inception in 1992 and desires to continue doing so by providing technical assistance, contributing financially to the Stockyards City Business Improvement District, and enforcing the design guidelines for the Stockyards City Design District.
