RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY TO ACCEPT A \$25,500 SUB-GRANT AWARD FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY -FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ADMINISTRATION PASSED THROUGH TO THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND HOMELAND SECURITY (“ODEMHS”) FISCAL YEAR 2023 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (“2023 PROGRAM”), AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE SUB-GRANT AGREEMENT, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT ACCEPTANCE, A BUDGET DETAIL WORKSHEET, REIMBURSEMENT CLAIMS, REQUEST OF FUNDS, AND PROVIDE REPORTS AS REQUIRED, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO RECEIVE AND DEPOSIT THE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security (“ODEMHS”) has selected The City of Oklahoma City to receive a proposed sub-grant award in the amount of \$25,500, pursuant to the Fiscal Year 2023 Homeland Security Grant Program.; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that equipment purchased will be owned and operated by The City of Oklahoma City; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Administration has provided funding for Fiscal Year 2023 Homeland Security Grant Program, Award No. 1550.052 (“2023 Program”) for the purchase of Starlink satellite equipment and service; and

WHEREAS, the sub-grant award amount of \$25,500 has been approved by the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security (“ODEMHS”) in concert with approval of a Detailed Budget Worksheet for the specific Starlink satellite equipment, as submitted by the City's Information Technology Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the \$25,500 sub-grant, from the ODEMHS, Grant No. 1550.052, be accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of The City of Oklahoma City that the Mayor is authorized to execute the contract, and that the City Manager or designee is authorized to submit acceptance, budget detail worksheet, reimbursement claims, request of funds, and provide reports as required; and authorizing the City Treasurer to receive and deposit the funds.
