**NOTICE OF PUBLIC DRAWINGS FOR WATERFOWL BLIND SITES AT LAKE OVERHOLSER AND LAKE DRAPER**

This is to advise that public drawings will be held on September 14, 2024, for the waterfowl blind sites at Lake Overholser/Stinchcomb Wildlife Refuge and Lake Stanley Draper. Drawing registration will start promptly at 10:00 a.m. for Lake Draper with the Overholser/Stinchcomb drawing immediately following. All participants must have an OKC annual hunting permit before the drawing starts.

**LAKE OVERHOLSE**

Duck Season

\*First half opens November 9 thru November 24, 2024

\*Second half opens November 30, 2024, thru January 26, 2025

**LAKE DRAPER**

Duck Season

\*First half opens November 9 thru November 24, 2024

\*Second half opens November 30, 2024, thru January 26, 2025

Light Geese

(Snow, Blue, & Ross)

\*First half opens November 2 thru November 24, 2024

\*Second half opens November 30, 2024, thru February 9, 2025

Dark Geese

(All Geese, except White  
Fronted, and Light Geese)

\*First half opens November 2 thru November 24, 2024

\*Second half opens November 30, 2024, thru February 9, 2025

White Fronted

\*First half opens November 2 thru November 24, 2024

\*Second half opens November 30, 2024, thru February 2, 2025

Blind sites will not be posted in the field. For blind site locations, see maps located at the Overholser Police Lake Patrol Station or Lake Draper Marina. Blind sites will not be any closer than 250-300 feet from each other. Persons drawing blinds sites must build the blind structure on that site no later than three (3) days before the opening of the first half of the waterfowl season. Failure to do so will result in the site being reassigned without further notice. **It is the responsibility of each person assigned a blind site to remove the structure no later than fifteen (15) days from the closing of goose season. Failure to comply with blind site rules will result in the applicant being rendered ineligible for future blind drawings.**

All persons wanting to participate in the blind drawing must be eighteen (18) years of age with an annual hunting permit. Persons under sixteen (16) years of age may hunt only when accompanied by a person twenty-one (21) years of age or older. An annual City hunting permit is required to participate in the drawing. Annual permits are \$12.50. Permits may be purchased in advance online at [okc.gov/parks](http://okc.gov/parks).

A copy of the blind site locations and hunting regulations will be posted at the drawing site. All hunting must be from designated blinds. **There will be no bank hunting or hunting from watercraft. All watercraft used to transport hunters to and from the blind locations must have a current city boating permit,** which can be obtained, at the drawing site. All Federal and State laws regarding the hunting of migratory waterfowl, as well as local City Ordinances will be enforced.

**DRAWINGS FOR WATERFOWL BLIND SITES AT LAKE OVERHOLSER AND LAKE STANLEY DRAPER**

**\*\*\* PROCEDURE CHANGES- PLEASE NOTE \*\*\***

- Blind Drawing participation will be limited to those persons holding a current City Annual Hunting Permit. To secure a drawn site, the hunter must present a valid annual hunting permit at registration. Permits may be purchased at the Lake Draper Marina.
- Blind sites will not be posted in the field. For blind site locations, see maps located at the Overholser Police Lake Patrol Station and at Lake Stanley Draper Marina.
- Blind sites will not be any closer than 250-300 feet from each other.
- It is the responsibility of each person assigned a blind site to remove the structure no later than fifteen (15) days from the close of goose season. Failure to comply with blind site rules will result in the applicant being rendered ineligible for future blind drawings.
- All persons wanting to participate in the blind drawing must be eighteen (18) years of age. Persons under sixteen (16) years of age may hunt only when accompanied by a person twenty-one (21) years of age or older.
- All hunting must be from designated blinds.
- **There will be no bank hunting or hunting from watercraft.** All watercraft used to transport hunters to and from the blind locations must have a current city boating permit.
- City Ordinance prohibits driving on the lake bottom.
- All Federal and State laws regarding the hunting of migratory waterfowl, as well as local City Ordinances will be enforced.
