Ratifying and approving Addendum No. 1; awarding contract to Wynn Construction Co. Inc., Project MP-0629, Bricktown Canal Lighting Improvements, Lower Bricktown Canal, \$1,146,000; assigning ECS Southwest, LLP as the testing laboratory; and approving contract and bonds. Ward 7.

Location:

Lower Bricktown Canal

Background:

This Capital Improvement and American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) project provides for the installation of new and updated site lighting serving the Lower Bricktown Canal area. The addition of updated lighting fixtures will make the area safer and more inviting for residents and visitors.

The project was advertised and bids were received from prospective bidders. Addendum No. 1 was issued to answer questions in Periscope, establish a construction and mobilization start date, and indicate the special hours of operations for the contractor.

Construction is scheduled to begin in early 2025 and be completed in Summer 2025.
