

EXTENSION OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING  
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA  
CITY AND THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE,  
LODGE 123

WHEREAS, the City of Oklahoma City, hereinafter referenced as the City, and the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge 123, hereinafter referenced as FOP, have a collective bargaining agreement for fiscal year 2022-2023, which addresses the wages, hours, and working conditions of Oklahoma City employees represented by FOP. The 2022-2023 collective bargaining agreement operates through June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, representatives for management and labor have been negotiating for a collective bargaining agreement for fiscal year 2023-2024, but the parties have yet to reach a tentative agreement to recommend to the City Council and to the FOP membership; and

WHEREAS, the parties believe it to be in their best interest to extend the 2022-2023 collective bargaining agreement as negotiations progress.

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE to extend the terms and conditions of the 2022-2023 collective bargaining agreement until a successor contract is agreed upon for 2023-2024, or until August 29, 2023, whichever occurs first.
