

JOINT RESOLUTION

JOINT RESOLUTION APPROVING COMPREHENSIVE RETAINER AGREEMENT BETWEEN OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AUTHORITY AND THE BEST AND SHARP LAW FIRM FOR LEGAL DEFENSE OF CITY EMPLOYEES, NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000 FROM JULY 1, 2024, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2025.

WHEREAS, on March 24, 1987, the City Council adopted a policy which recognized the potential conflict of interest between The City and its employees which arises in certain litigation when the employees are sued for punitive damages or an actual conflict of interest arises between the employee and The City, and directed that a City employee, who is entitled to legal counsel by The City, shall be permitted to select outside counsel to be retained on his/her behalf; and

WHEREAS, on this date, the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority has adopted a resolution which authorizes the OCMFA to administer such agreements; and

WHEREAS, Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority desires to enter into a retainer agreement with the Best and Sharp law firm for defense of City employees; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Oklahoma City approve the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority's entering into retainer agreements with this firm;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City and the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma City Municipal Facilities Authority that the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for the legal defense of the City's employees with the Best and Sharp law firm, not to exceed \$100,000 from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.
