Description of Impact

Jeffrey Dixon, P.E., Vice President with Crafton Tull Inc., on behalf of their client, REHCO, LLC, has submitted a request for a reserved parking space for the physically disabled within the limits of existing on-street angle parking on the north side of NW 9th Street west of North Hudson Avenue. The requested location is adjacent to a mixed-use office building and parking garage presently under construction at 424 NW 10th Street.

At their regular meeting on February 19, 2024, the Oklahoma City Traffic and Transportation Commission voted in favor of the request and recommended it for approval by the City Council.
