Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in approving Amendment No. 3 to Contract for Engineering Services with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., Project SC-0915, Lift Station Improvements (11 locations), fee increase of \$218,000. Ward 1.

Background:

This project provides for an evaluation and life cycle cost analysis with the intent of reducing or eliminating as many lift stations as possible and replacing them with gravity sanitary sewer lines.

Subsequent to execution of the original contract as previously amended and due to the acquisition of an easement for Lift Station No. 52 (located in Area 4), it has been determined to direct the Engineer to re-design the lift station in the southeast corner of the property to minimize the impact to the property owner's usable space. This re-design necessitates a wetland delineation and nationwide permit memo due to the proposed work being within the floodway and floodplain. The Engineer will be required to provide all services related to the permit, and six additional months of construction administration and inspection services for construction of the lift stations.
