Ratifying and approving Addendum No. 1; awarding contract to Wynn Construction Company, Inc., Project MP-0539-II, C.B. Cameron Park Lighting Package, 11711 North Portland Avenue, \$1,170,000; assigning Terracon Consulting as the testing laboratory; and approving contract and bonds. Ward 8.

**Location:**

11711 North Portland Avenue

**Background:**

On February 1, 2022 (Item No. IX.BJ.), City Council approved twelve (12) of the highest rated projects from a list of restoration projects to be funded under the Revenue Replacement category. C. B. Cameron Park Lighting Package was one of the projects identified. As part of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA), this project was allocated \$1,500,000 million to provide lighting improvements including light poles, light pole footings, luminaires, electrical panel, electrical receptacles, and electrical conductors.

The project was advertised and bids were received from prospective bidders. Addendum No. 1 was required to provide clarifications of plans and materials.

Construction is scheduled to begin Spring, 2024 and be completed in Summer, 2024.
