

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BOOMI SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT AVAILABLE FROM OMNIA PARTNERS COOPERATIVE (COKC01117), ESTIMATED COST \$145,000, NOVEMBER 21, 2024 THROUGH NOVEMBER 20, 2025.

WHEREAS, the Information Technology Department has a continuing need for the purchase of Boomi software maintenance and support; and

WHEREAS, Boomi software is utilized to manage data integrations between IT applications for use by City departments; and

WHEREAS, Boomi software is used in conjunction with several projects by the Utilities Department; and

WHEREAS, Boomi software is a middleware that connects different systems to allow for easier integration, creation, and management; and

WHEREAS, the integrations are what allow data to be transferred back and forth; and

WHEREAS, the City will be purchasing from an existing government contract through OMNIA Partners public sector purchasing cooperative; and

WHEREAS, this contract provides access to discounted pricing from Dell Marketing LP; and

WHEREAS, OMNIA Partners is a purchasing cooperative benefitting public agencies by providing national pricing through competitively solicited proposals; and

WHEREAS, the approval of this contract follows the same procedures when purchasing from State contracts, and

WHEREAS, staff requests Council authorize the purchase of Boomi software maintenance and support from Dell Marketing LP, through the OMNIA Partners public sector purchasing cooperative (COKC01117), estimated cost \$145,000, November 21, 2024 through November 20, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for this cooperative agreement is based on previous expenditures for this commodity; and

WHEREAS, the City is under no obligation to purchase from this agreement; and

WHEREAS, all purchases are subject to future appropriations and the availability of funds and all applicable provisions of Oklahoma law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of Oklahoma City that they do hereby authorize the purchase of Boomi software maintenance and support from Dell Marketing LP, available through the OMNIA Partners public sector purchasing cooperative (COKC01117), subject to the appropriations and availability of funds, estimated cost \$145,000, November 21, 2024 through November 20, 2025, and in accordance with all the provisions of Oklahoma Law.
