RESOLUTION APPROVING SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE ASSOCIATION OF CENTRAL OKLAHOMA GOVERNMENTS FOR AN AIR QUALITY SMALL GRANT FOR UP TO \$1,000,000 (ONE MILLION DOLLARS) TO IMPLEMENT SIX (6) BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS, INCLUDING: INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS ALONG THE NORTH I-240 SERVICE ROAD, FROM SOUTH BYERS AVENUE TO SOUTH SANTA FE AVENUE; INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS ALONG THE NORTH I-240 SERVICE ROAD, FROM SOUTH WALKER AVENUE TO SOUTH WESTERN AVENUE; INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF NORTH MERIDIAN AVENUE FROM NORTHWEST 36TH STREET TO NORTHWEST 50TH STREET; INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF NORTH PENNSYLVANIA FROM W.P. BILL ATKINSON Q. BOULEVARD TO NORTHWEST 133RD STREET, AND ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF NORTHWEST 140TH STREET FROM QUAIL SPRINGS MALL TO NORTH KENTUCKY AVENUE; INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF NORTHEAST 16TH STREET, FROM THE KATY TRAIL TO REDBUD DRIVE; AND INSTALLATION OF BIKE LANES ON NORTHEAST 4TH STREET FROM NORTH LOTTIE AVENUE TO NORTH MARTIN LUTHER KING AVENUE, AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2023, the Association of Central Oklahoma Governments (ACOG) issued a request for applications for the Air Quality Small Grant competitive grant program; and

WHEREAS, the program is made possible with Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds; and

WHEREAS, awarded projects will include active transportation infrastructure and improvements, transit improvements, and congestion reduction efforts that strive to improve regional air quality by reducing reliance on single-occupancy vehicle trips; and

WHEREAS, this application requests grant funding for sidewalks and on-street bicycle infrastructure, as well as associated signage for six (6) projects identified by or consistent with the City's bicycle-pedestrian master plan, bikewalkokc; and

WHEREAS, grant guidelines state that the maximum award amount is \$1,000,000, and a local match of at least 20% is required, if awarded; and

WHEREAS, no City funds are committed by applying for the grant; and

WHEREAS, if selected for funding, City Council will be asked to receive the award, and the match portion will be funded by the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) Fund; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for applications is September 29, 2023; and

WHEREAS, as part of the application process, ACOG requires an adopted Resolution stating the submitting agency's commitment to the Project; and

WHEREAS, ACOG is expected to notify applicants of award status in November 2023.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City, that:
