

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE IN THE COST ESTIMATE FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL AND SAFETY, UNITS, PARTS AND SUPPLIES, AVERY DENNISON CORPORATION (C236037), BATTERIES SOONER, LLC DBA BATTERIES PLUS (C236038), CONSOLIDATED TRAFFIC CONTROL, INC. (C236039), CUBIC ITS, INC. (C236040), ICM OF AMERICA, INC. (C236041), ITS PLUS, INC. (C236042), ITERIS, INC. (C236043), PARADIGM TRAFFIC SYSTEMS, INC. (C236044), PINKLEY SALES CO. (C236045) AND WAVETRONIX, LLC (C236046), ESTIMATED COST INCREASE OF \$700,000 TO A TOTAL OF \$1,450,000 FOR THE PERIOD ENDING JANUARY 30, 2024; AND AUTHORIZING A CHANGE IN THE COST ESTIMATE FOR THE OPEN MARKET PURCHASE OF RELATED SUPPLIES NOT AVAILABLE ON A PRICING AGREEMENT (OM23-C236047), ESTIMATED COST INCREASE OF \$100,000 TO A TOTAL OF \$175,000, FOR THE PERIOD ENDING JANUARY 30, 2024.

WHEREAS, the pricing agreements were originally awarded January 31, 2023 (Item No. IX. E.1&2) for the period ended January 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Public Works has bond projects in addition to regularly scheduled projects which require traffic control and safety supplies that utilize these pricing agreements; and,

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2023 (Item No. IX. BS) the City Council approved a bond project that will provide for equipment inventory for the Traffic Services Division within the Public Works Department. Public Works has determined an additional \$700,000 is needed for equipment and supplies and an additional \$100,000 for open market purchases. The equipment purchase includes signal poles, mast arms, electrical wire, conduit, LED signal heads, lenses, and other related traffic signal equipment. This inventory will be used to repair and replace equipment damaged at intersections throughout the City. The additional \$800,000 requested would allow adequate purchasing authority through the period ending January 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works department has determined the services, equipment, and supplies will cost approximately \$800,000; and

WHEREAS, the \$800,000 increase is to allow Public Works and other City and Trust departments to utilize the contracts through the term ending January 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, projects will be funded from Traffic Bond funds in addition to various funds and accounts; and

WHEREAS, staff requests Council authorize a change in the cost estimate for traffic control and safety, units, parts and supplies, Avery Dennison Corporation (C236037), Batteries Sooner, LLC DBA Batteries Plus (C236038), Consolidated Traffic Control, Inc. (C236039), Cubic ITS, Inc. (C236040), ICM of America, Inc. (C236041), ITS Plus, Inc. (C236042), Iteris, Inc. (C236043), Paradigm Traffic Systems, Inc. (C236044), Pinkley Sales Co. (C236045) and Wavetronix, LLC (C236046), estimated cost increase of \$700,000 to a total of \$1,450,000 for the period ending January 30, 2024; and authorizing a change in the cost estimate for the open market purchase of related supplies not available on a pricing agreement (OM23-C236047), estimated cost increase of \$100,000 to a total of \$175,000, for the period ending January 30, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of Oklahoma City that they do authorize a change in the cost estimate for traffic control and safety, units, parts and supplies, Avery Dennison Corporation (C236037), Batteries Sooner, LLC DBA Batteries Plus (C236038), Consolidated Traffic Control, Inc. (C236039), Cubic ITS, Inc. (C236040), ICM of America, Inc. (C236041), ITS Plus, Inc. (C236042), Iteris, Inc. (C236043), Paradigm Traffic Systems, Inc. (C236044), Pinkley Sales Co. (C236045) and Wavetronix, LLC (C236046), estimated cost increase of \$700,000 to a total of \$1,450,000 for the period ending January 30, 2024; and authorizing a change in the cost estimate for the open market purchase of related supplies not available on a pricing agreement (OM23-C236047), estimated cost increase of \$100,000 to a total of \$175,000, for the period ending January 30, 2024.
