

RESOLUTION

JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY AND THE OKLAHOMA CITY WATER UTILITIES TRUST EXTENDING TIME TO AWARD CONTRACT AND AWARDING JOINT CONTRACT TO RUDY CONSTRUCTION CO. AS BEST AND LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER FOR PROJECT TC-0506 AND WC- 1020-1, INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AND WATERMAIN REPLACEMENTS, NORTH PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE AT NW 10TH STREET AND NORTH VIRGINIA AVENUE, \$5,639,436.85; ASSIGNING CEC CORPORATION AS TESTING LABORATORY; AND APPROVING JOINT CONTRACT AND BONDS.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has determined Rudy Construction Co. was the lowest and best bidder for Project TC-0506 and WC-1020-1, Intersection Improvements and Watermain Replacements, North Pennsylvania Avenue at NW 10th Street and North Virginia Avenue; and

WHEREAS, provisions of the Oklahoma State law known as the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974, provides a contract for construction of a public improvement be awarded within 30 days or within 45 days for good cause shown or within 120 days upon mutual agreement between the lowest responsible bidder and the awarding public agency or agencies; and

WHEREAS, bids were received on October 16, 2024, and due to bid evaluation and time need to receive executed contract and bonds, contract award was delayed, preventing award within 30 days of receipt of bids. and

WHEREAS, a letter agreeing to honor the bid for 45 days has been received from Rudy Construction Co.; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Public Works Department to award the contract to Rudy Construction Co. as the lowest and best responsible bidder in the amount of \$5,639,436.85.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Oklahoma City and the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust that they do hereby extend time to award, and award joint contract to Rudy Construction Co. as the lowest and best responsible bidder for Project TC-0506 and WC-1020-1, Intersection Improvements and Watermain Replacements, North Pennsylvania Avenue at NW 10th Street and North Virginia Avenue, \$5,639,436.85; assigning CEC Corporation as testing laboratory; and approving joint contract and bonds.
