Resolution appointing Edward Hasbrook as Municipal Judge effective July 1, 2025 for a two-year term expiring July 1, 2027.

**Background:**

The legislature has enacted 11 O.S. 2011 §28-103 which provides in part that the City governing body shall appoint and fix the compensation of Judges; that the Judges shall serve for a two year term, expiring on the date fixed by ordinance and the Judges shall serve until their successors are appointed or qualified.

Section 33-22 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2020, provides for staggering the terms of office for the Municipal Judges. The term of office for Municipal Judges shall be for two years and shall expire on July 1.

If approved, the resolution will appoint Edward Hasbrook as Municipal Judge beginning July 1, 2025 upon taking the oath of office and the term will expire July 1, 2027. The salary will be established by separate resolution for the Municipal Judges.
