Ordinance to be introduced and set for final hearing removing all parking controls on both sides of North Lottie Avenue from NE 4th Street to NE 8th Street and from NE 13th Street to NE 23rd Street. Ward 7

Originating Department: Public Works

Description of Impact

Geoffrey Butler, Planning Director, has submitted a request to restructure North Lottie Avenue from a four-lane roadway to a two-lane roadway with parking protected bicycle lanes on both sides of the street as a part of Oklahoma City Project PC-0738, Lottie Bicycle Infrastructure Project. Under Project PC-0738, it is requested to remove all existing on-street regulatory parking controls on both sides of North Lottie Avenue between NE 4th Street and NE 8th Street and between NE 13th Street and NE 23rd Street. This is in accordance with §32-484, Motor vehicles in bicycle lanes, which prohibits parking within bicycle lanes.

At their regular meeting on October 16, 2023, the Oklahoma City Traffic and Transportation Commission voted in favor of the requested changes and recommended them for approval by the City Council.
