RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNSELOR TO CONFESS JUDGMENT WITHOUT AN ADMISSION OF LIABILITY IN THE CASE OF *JEFFERY EARLE LASSITER V. CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA; AND OKLAHOMA CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, A SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY*, UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE WESTERN DISTRICT OF OKLAHOMA, CASE NO. CIV-23-621-JD

WHEREAS, the lawsuit styled *Jeffery Earle Lassiter v. City of Oklahoma City, a Political subdivision of the State of Oklahoma; and Oklahoma City Police Department, a subdivision of the City of Oklahoma City*, Case No. CIV-23-621-JD has been filed in United States District Court for the Western District of Oklahoma;

WHEREAS, the City of Oklahoma City has been named as defendant in this lawsuit;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the settlement of this case in the amount of Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000) is a just and reasonable settlement of said case;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to make such settlement by authorizing the Municipal Counselor to draft the necessary paperwork to settle this case on behalf of the defendant and to prepare and file a Journal Entry of Judgment, which does not admit liability in said case.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY that the Municipal Counselor be and he is hereby directed to prepare and file any and all necessary paperwork to effectuate this settlement, including a Journal Entry of Judgment confessing Judgment without admitting liability.
