

RESOLUTION WAIVING FORMAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND
AUTHORIZING THE OPEN MARKET PURCHASE OF VARIOUS
METAL PRODUCTS (COKC00184), ESTIMATED COST \$100,000,
JULY 1, 2024 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2025.

WHEREAS, the City and Trusts have a continuing need to purchase various metal products to include steel, aluminum, copper, iron, pipe, rebar, bar stock, and sheet metal for ongoing work activities; and

WHEREAS, due to the continued unstable market conditions for these products, staff has not found vendors who are willing to commit to a one-year pricing agreement; and

WHEREAS, departments will obtain three informal price quotes for purchases greater than \$5,000 to ensure the best pricing is received at the time of purchase; and

WHEREAS, staff requests open market authority for the purchase of various metal products (COKC00184), estimated cost \$100,000, July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, purchases made with this authority will comply with the City's open market purchasing procedures; and


WHEREAS, there is a continuing need for the purchase of these materials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of The City of Oklahoma City that they do hereby waive formal competitive bidding and authorize the open market purchase of various metal products (COKC00184), estimated cost \$100,000, July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025.
