Public Pedestrian At-Grade Crossing Agreement with Union Pacific Railway Company, Projects MP-0487R and MP-0545, Greenway Trail along the Oklahoma River Trail and Wayfinding, Union Pacific Real Estate Project No. 0779894. Ward 7.

Location:

South Grand Boulevard Trail/Tinker-Draper Trail/Eagles Lake Trail to Oklahoma River Trail/Katy Trail

Background:

This 2007 General Obligation Bond Authorization project provides for trail improvements to provide improved connectivity between the Oklahoma River Trail, the Eagle Lake Trail, the Grand Trail, the Tinker/Draper Trail and the Katy Trail.

The agreement allows for the City of Oklahoma City to construct a new at-grade public pedestrian trail crossing under the Union Pacific's rail bridge over the Oklahoma River. The City's cost of \$10,185 will be paid by the contractor Wynn Construction Co., Inc.
