Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in adopting a Resolution ratifying the actions of the General Manager in declaring an emergency; waiving competitive bidding; and issuing Emergency Purchase Order No. 06262024SMK15; and authorizing payments for services and equipment until the emergency is resolved, estimated cost \$675,000. Ward 2.

Location:

NW 36th Street and Meridian Avenue

Purpose:

To ratify the actions of the General Manager in declaring an emergency.

Justification:

To allow for the immediate mobilization of a crew from Rangeline to perform line stops.

Background:

On June 26, 2024, a request was submitted to the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust General Manager to authorize an emergency purchase order for Rangeline Utility Services, LLC due to a lack of pressure in the distribution system. The contractor performed a line stop and replaced the inoperable 20-inch butterfly valve at NW 36th Street and Meridian Avenue. It was in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare that repairs be done timely to restore operational capacity in the area.
