Joint Resolution with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust ratifying the actions of the General Manager in declaring an emergency and issuing an emergency work order utilizing The City of Oklahoma City's On-Call Contract with Cimarron Construction Company, LLC, Project SC-1121, Emergency Sanitary Sewer Repairs, NW 33rd Street and Drexel Boulevard, \$221,349.94, and NW Expressway east of Meridian Avenue, \$523,626.49. Ward 2.

Location:

NW 33rd Street and Drexel Boulevard
NW Expressway east of Meridian Avenue

Purpose:

To ratify the actions of the General Manager in declaring an emergency.

Justification:

The existing sanitary sewer and drainage pipes must be repaired due to multiple collapses and failures. The needed repair is beyond the present abilities of the line maintenance crews and equipment.

Background:

Approximately 289 linear feet of 8-inch concrete pipe and 291 linear feet of 12-inch cast iron pipe (CIP) will be replaced, and adjoining manholes will be replaced to restore operational capacity in the area. The sanitary sewer locations are below and parallel with the large storm drain structures and pipes; thus, it was determined necessary to remove and replace the storm drain to access the sanitary sewer. Due to the sanitary sewer locations currently being bypassed by Line Maintenance, it was deemed beneficial to award the emergency project to Cimarron Construction Company, LLC. The contractor currently has an on-call contract with The City of Oklahoma City (City) for a unit-price drainage repair (DC-0323), and both locations will involve large amounts of drainage repair.
