Resolution authorizing the sole source purchase of MAGNUSWorx Peak Performance and Wellness Application from Readiness Network, Inc. dba International Academy of Public Safety (COKC01453), estimated cost \$140,000, retroactive to January 31, 2025 through January 30, 2026.

Purpose:

To provide the Oklahoma City Police Department Wellness Unit with an application that will amplify their efforts in providing unlimited health and wellness resources for employees.

Background:

The Police Department has a continuous need for wellness related services for police officers and their families. These customized wellness services address critical areas such as mental health, emotional resiliency, physical fitness, sleep, hygiene, and communication within relationships. The MAGNUSWorx App provides 24/7 resources to Police Department employees and their families. These resources include highly specialized counselors who work with First Responders dealing with mental health issues, while also helping to reduce the negative stigma associated with seeking help for emotional or mental health concerns. This app offers curated content developed and managed by the Police Department's Wellness Team and other subject matter experts. This ensures the resources are uniquely tailored to the needs of First Responders, distinguishing it from other mental health apps on the market. The MAGNUSWorx's app is exclusively available to First Responders and provides invaluable feedback on the mental health needs of our employees, offering insight into the effectiveness of our current mental health programs.

Currently, the Department's Wellness Unit includes four full-time staff members, one Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) and about 45 part-time peers currently serving roughly 1,200 sworn officers, plus 300-400 civilian employees and their families. The Wellness Unit has set a goal of serving 2,800 to 3,200 Police Department employees and their families.

MAGNUSWorx Peak Performance and Wellness application content can be customized to help employees maximize the benefits from using this application. The content is specifically geared towards building resiliency, addressing emotional injuries, physical and mental health issues or needs they may have as well as maintaining the confidentiality of the user. This application also allows for content to be customized specifically for the Police Department and the unique mental health challenges faced by officers.
