

## **RESOLUTION**

### **RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND APPROVING EXECUTION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDING AGREEMENTS WITH SUB-GRANTEES AWARDED FUNDS IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 FOURTH YEAR ANNUAL ACTION PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Oklahoma City (City) has received allocations of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds since 1975, to primarily benefit persons of low income; and

**WHEREAS**, CDBG funding for FY 2023-24, in the amount of \$4,907,677, was authorized through a federal allocation of funds by Congress to the City, for the performance period July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the policy of The City of Oklahoma City to commit the use of these funds in the most efficient way possible, to meet the needs of its populations of lower income; including the use of subgrants to partner agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council's May 9, 2023 Resolution approving the FY 2023-24 Fourth Year Annual Action Plan (Item No. XI.W.) authorized the Mayor to sign funding agreements with sub-grantees, including the Community Action Agency, Community Health Centers, Inc., Court Appointed Special Advocates of Oklahoma County, SISU Youth Services, Oklahoma City Urban Renewal Authority, Oklahoma City Housing Authority, Metropolitan Fair Housing Agency, and Central Oklahoma Transportation and Parking Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has executed Agreements with partnering agencies to implement direct funding allocations to Sub-grantees identified in the Resolution approving the FY 2023-24 Fourth Year Annual Action Plan approved by City Council on May 9, 2023; and


**WHEREAS**, all executed CDBG Agreements approved on May 9, 2023, excluding SISU Youth Services which did not receive new funding in the FY 2023-24 program year, have been fully executed by all parties, and are ready for ratification;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of The City of Oklahoma City hereby ratifies and approves the Mayor's execution of the following:

1. CDBG Funding Agreements with Community Action Agency (Emergency Home Repair and Small Business Assistance), Community Health Centers Inc., Court Appointed Special Advocates, Oklahoma City Urban Renewal Authority, Oklahoma City Housing Authority, Metropolitan Fair Housing Agency, and Central Oklahoma Transportation and Parking Authority;
