Revocable Permit with the Heartland Racing Co. for the “Go Girl Run OKC,” March 22, 2025, Boathouse District, Regatta Park, Wiley Post Park, the parking lot of the Exchange Avenue Boathouse, and the South Oklahoma River Trail, revenue of \$2,525. Wards 4, 6 and 7.

### **Location:**

Boathouse District, Regatta Park, Wiley Post Park, the parking lot of the Exchange Avenue Boathouse, and the South Oklahoma River Trail.

### **Background:**

Heartland Racing Co (Permittee) desires a Revocable Permit (Permit) to hold the “Go Girl Run OKC” (Event), as described above. Permittee will, at its expense, plan, organize, and manage the Event.

The Permit will be effective when approved by the City. It will authorize Permittee to use the Event site, from 5:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 22, 2025.

In addition to the other rights granted herein, this Permit shall authorize Permittee to use public rights-of-way to create a Running Course, **temporarily closing the curbside northbound lane of South Lincoln Boulevard** from Southeast 6th Street south to South Central Avenue.

Permittee must provide required insurance and indemnification; protect City property; and comply with applicable laws, rules, and regulations. As consideration, Permittee will pay OCRRA \$2,525. On February 25, 2025, OCRRA recommended approval of the Permit.

### **Revenue:**

\$2,525 to be deposited in OCRRA UNASN – OCRRA – PARKS CHG-SPECIAL EVENTS (5500 – REV3000 – 42050005)
