

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY TO ACCEPT AN \$800 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE TRAINING GRANT REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND HOMELAND SECURITY; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE POLICE BUSINESS MANAGER OR MANAGEMENT SPECIALIST TO SUBMIT THE ACCEPTANCE, APPROVE CLAIMS, REQUEST FUNDS, AND PROVIDE REPORTS AS REQUIRED; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO RECEIVE AND DEPOSIT THE FUNDS IN THE GRANTS MANAGEMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, the City has a comprehensive emergency management program that is the responsibility of the Office of Emergency Management, a subordinate unit of the Oklahoma City Police Department reporting directly to the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the grant opportunity is designed to reimburse emergency managers of local jurisdictions for attending important training and conference opportunities designated to increase their knowledge and ability to better prepare for and respond to emergencies and disasters within their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of funds approved for the grant period of October 1, 2023, through September 30, 2025, is \$800. A grant match is not required with this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City to accept the \$800 FEMA Emergency Management Performance Training Grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City authorizing the mayor to sign any necessary documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of The City of Oklahoma City that, the Police Business Manager or Management Specialist are authorized to submit the acceptance, approve claims, request funds, and provide reports as required and the City Treasurer

is authorized to receive and deposit the funds in the grants management fund.
