OCTOBER 1, 2024

I. Call to Order. 3:34 p.m.

Vice Chair Chelsea Banks called the meeting to order. Debby Hampton and Michelle Blasquez were absent.

II. Items for Individual Consideration

A. Approve Minutes of the September 3, 2024 MAPS 4 Citizens Advisory Board Community Subcommittee Special Meeting

APPROVED. Moved by Walke, seconded by Callahan. Ayes: Walke, Banks, Callahan, Hall, Mata, Ross. Absent: Morris.

B. Recommend approval of site for Project M4-MM011, MAPS 4 Mental Health Crisis Center, 1200 NE 13th Street. Ward 7.

A. J. Kirkpatrick of ADG Blatt presented the timeline of activity for the project, the map of similar facilities in 2019 when the MAPS 4 vote was passed, the nine similar facilities built or planned since 2019, and the proposed site for this project. He noted the land could be donated, and the Arnall Foundation offered to pay for the demolition of the existing buildings. He explained the three perspectives of site selection and the budget.

Ms. Mata asked if there was any data for veterans with mental illness and if the facility would treat veterans. Mr. Kirkpatrick answered veterans would be treated. Allie Friesen of Oklahoma Mental Health and Substance Abuse agreed veterans would be treated and housed if the VA Hospital was full. She noted there was not mental health data just for veterans.

Crystal Denker of SA.Studio presented the project summary, building programming, site analysis, the building concept, and test fit options. Ms. Hall asked if the Lottie House would be relocated. Mr. Kirkpatrick replied discussions are underway about relocating the facility. Ms. Hall remarked Lottie House needs to stay in that area of town and agreed this site was the best bet for the MAPS 4 Crisis Center.


