**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPAL COUNSELOR TO CONFESS JUDGMENT WITHOUT ADMITTING LIABILITY IN THE CASE OF *ALISHA COULTER AND JUSTIN COULTER, BOTH AS INDIVIDUALS AND ON BEHALF OF J.C., J.C., AND J.C., ALL MINORS V. CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY*, OKLAHOMA COUNTY DISTRICT CASE NUMBER CJ-2024-235**

**WHEREAS**, the lawsuit styled *Alisha Coulter and Justin Coulter, both as individuals and on behalf of J.C., J.C., and J.C., all minors v. City of Oklahoma City* has been filed in the District Court for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that a settlement of this lawsuit in the amount of THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$35,000) dollars, is a just and reasonable settlement of said case;


