Ratifying and approving Addenda Nos. 1 and 2, Project AE-0006, Prairie Surf Demolition, 1 Myriad Gardens; awarding contract with Oklahoma City Public Property Authority to Midwest Wrecking Co., LLC, \$11,474,840; and approving contract and bonds. Ward 7.

Background:

The building formerly known as the Myriad and Cox Convention Center and is now known as Prairie Surf Studios will be demolished for the construction of a first-class, state-of-the-art NBA arena and entertainment venue, which includes at least 750,000 square feet.

Addendum No. 1 was issued on February 28, 2025 to extend the bid date and bid question date and to revise the plans and specifications. Addendum No. 2 was issued on March 7, 2025 to revise the plans and specifications. Bids were opened on March 12, 2025, for the Prairie Surf Demolition project with four bids received. The project architect, owner's representative and City staff reviewed the bids and recommend awarding the base bid only to the lowest and best bidder, Midwest Wrecking Co., LLC.
