SUBJECT: OLETS – Sole Source Vendor

Every year, the Police Department pays the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety for the annual user fee of their Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (OLETS)

OLETS provides a computerized message switching system to provide for the interstate, intrastate and interagency exchange of criminal justice related information 24 hours a day, seven days a week and is a vital tool for the daily operation of the OCPD. The Oklahoma Department of Public Safety is the sole source provider of law enforcement telecommunications systems for the State of Oklahoma.

The breakdown charges are:

7 Full access terminals located in the Crime Information Unit @ \$350.00 for a total of \$2,450.00 per month. The total amount for the year \$29,400.00.

1 CAD terminal server @ \$25.00 per month. Total amount for the year \$300.00.

243 Query LITE Terminals @ \$25.00 per month for a total of \$6,075.00 per month. The total for the year \$72,900.00

842 MDC @ \$5.00 per device per month for a total amount of \$4,210.00 per month. Total for the year \$50,520.00

8 MDC @ \$5.00 per device per month for a total of \$40.00 per month. Total for the year \$480.00. These are specific to CITCO.

Estimated cost for FY2022-23 access \$153,600.00
