Resolution authorizing the purchase of emergency preparedness and safety equipment through a cooperative agreement with Houston-Galveston Area Council (CP25-C255120), estimated cost \$200,000, January 30, 2024 through January 29, 2025.

Purpose:

To authorize the purchase of emergency preparedness and safety equipment for the Fire Department through a cooperative agreement.

Background:

The Fire Department has a continuing need to purchase radiation and chemical detectors which are available through Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC). The H-GAC cooperative purchasing program, known as HGACBuy, benefits government agencies by providing national pricing through competitively solicited proposals. HGACBuy is a government-to-government cooperative purchasing program that has been in operation for over 30 years. The cooperative provides volume purchasing pricing and discounts to local governments, special districts, and non-profits providing a government service. This contract adoption will allow the Fire Department to purchase mass decontamination equipment, hazmat equipment, and radio equipment at a discounted price under H-GAC's contracts, Emergency Preparedness and Safety Equipment, #EP11-20.

The City is under no obligation to purchase from this agreement. All purchases are subject to future appropriations and the availability of funds.
