Concurrence with the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust in adopting a Resolution extending time to award contract, awarding contract to Krapff-Reynolds Construction Company, Project SC-1095, Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, North Western Avenue to North Blackwelder Avenue from Northwest Expressway to I-44, \$2,336,771.50; and approving contract and bonds. Ward 2.

Location:

North Western Avenue to North Blackwelder Avenue from Northwest Expressway to I-44

Purpose:

To extend the time to award, and to award a construction contract.

Background:

This project provides for the rehabilitation of 3,680 linear feet of sanitary sewer main due to deterioration. The necessary repairs will include rehabilitating the existing connecting manholes. It is in the best interest of public health, safety, and welfare that repairs be done timely to restore the operational capacity of the sanitary sewer system.

The Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 states that a contract for construction of a public improvement must be awarded within 30 days or within 45 days for good cause shown or within 120 days upon mutual agreement between the lowest responsible bidder and the awarding public agency or agencies. This contract was delayed due to necessary review period requirements and the meeting schedule of the Oklahoma City Water Utilities Trust; therefore, preventing award within 30 days of receipt of bids. A letter agreeing to honor the bid for an additional 30 days has been received from Krapff-Reynolds Construction Company.
