Amendment No. 1 to the Service Contract for Passenger Boarding Bridges Inspection, Maintenance, and Repair with Oshkosh AeroTech, LLC, formerly JBT AeroTech Corporation, who is authorized to conduct business in the State of Oklahoma.

**Location:**

Will Rogers World Airport

**Background:**

The Trust and JBT AeroTech Corporation (JBT) entered into a Service Contract for Passenger Boarding Bridges Inspection, Maintenance, and Repair on January 27, 2022 (Original Contract) to provide inspection, maintenance, and repair services for the passenger boarding bridges at Will Rogers World Airport. JBT has notified staff that it was acquired and underwent a conversion in its corporate structure to Oshkosh Aerotech, LLC (Oshkosh) as of February 16, 2024. From and after February 16, 2024, all references to JBT in the Original Contract shall be deemed to reference Oshkosh. Oshkosh accepts and assumes all performance requirements, responsibilities, and covenants contained in the Original Contract and agrees to strictly honor and comply with all terms, provisions, conditions, obligations, and liabilities created by or under the Original Contract as if it were an original contracting party to the Original Contract.

The City of Oklahoma City is not a party to the Service Contract for Passenger Boarding Bridges Inspection, Maintenance, and Repair with Oshkosh AeroTech, LLC but is approving this Amendment No. 1 to the Service Contract as required by the City's Lease Agreement with the Oklahoma City Airport Trust.
