Revocable Right-of-Way Use Permit with Oklahoma Mural Syndicate, to hold "Juneteenth on the East...With Love," June 17, 2023, NE 23rd Street between North Kelham Avenue and North Missouri Avenue, revenue of \$400. Ward 7.

NE 23rd Street between North Kelham Avenue and North Missouri Avenue, Northeast OKC

**Background:**

"Juneteenth on the East...With Love" is an annual community event celebrating Juneteenth and brings together artists from many different art forms: including music, dance, poetry, visual art and more. The event features food trucks, pop-up vendors, live music, an interactive community mural project and children's activities. This will be the 3rd year for the event.

The event will be open to the public from 3 p.m. to 9 p.m. The revocable permit would become effective in advance of the event at 10 a.m. and authorizes the closure until midnight, allowing sufficient time for setup, teardown and cleanup of the event.
