

To whom this may concern,

In regard to item CE-1112, AT&T formally contests and objects to the vacation and closing of the public easement in the following location:

A tract of land being a part of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section Twenty-Eight (28), Township Twelve (12) North, Range Three (3) West of the Indian Meridian, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, and being a portion of SCOTTS ADDITION according to the Plat recorded in Book PL1, Page 47, being more particularly described as follows:

All of the Westerly North-South Alley in said SCOTTS ADDITION from the South Right-of-Way line of N.W. 14th.

AT&T requires the pole line located in the western edge of this alleyway easement to provide internet access to the Garage Loft apartments and would cause significant expense to relocate these facilities. AT&T is also required to comply with the laws and regulations set forth by the Federal Communications Commission and has a requirement to continue to provide services to existing customers, and the vacation of this easement would affect AT&T's ability to provide services at this location.

AT&T requests that if the easement vacation is to be granted, that the requestor of the vacated easement provide compensation and adequate time for the relocation of our facilities.
